
Chords for Early Childhood Teachers



I have clustered songs by what chords you need to know to be able to play the song. If the only chords you know are F and C, that can take you a long way!! When the handout says (F), play an F chord there. If it says play that same chord again. On (C) switch to C chord.

Note: All tunes can be transposed into different keys. For example, while I like Wheels on the Bus best when I use F and C chords, other people may prefer playing D and A or C and G. The keys in this handout are optimized for the beginning musician.


It's Time
